St. Joseph's Institution International Malaysia (SJII Malaysia) opened its doors to students in August 2016 with 450 students and has now grown to over 700 students in total. Over the past 3 rounds of scholarships, 60 scholarships have been awarded to deserving students planning to take the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme in our school. We can already see the potential in our students to be leaders in the fields they aim to pursue upon graduation and we have high hopes for their success in the future.

SJII Malaysia was established by alumni of SJI Singapore. The aim being to remain true to the mission of the Founder, St. John Baptist De La Salle: the provision of quality values-based, holistic education for the young. Instilling the core values of Faith, Service and Community is at the heart of this institution producing servant-leaders in the society. University Counselling Services.

They will return to be senior leaders of SJII Malaysia upon completion of the programme.

A SCHOLAR'S REFLECTION



Having joined SJI in its founding year, I have seen the school flourish with new talents, new activities and new environments.

I am very grateful to have received a scholarship from SJIIM as it has given me the chance to study the vigorous yet prestigious IB diploma programme that I would not have been able to afford otherwise. It has also enabled me to study in a school that emphasises Lasallian core values and taught me how to be empathetic.

As scholars, we were given the golden opportunity to carry out service projects in the Philippines. This was a very unique experience for me as I could interact with children who spoke a language I, along with many of my peers, could not understand. The language barrier made it very difficult for us to communicate with the children and forced us to

step out of our comfort zones. Instead of communicating through speech, we resorted to hand gestures. Luckily, we had a classmate from the Philippines who aided us in our communication. This valuable volunteering experience helped to reinforce the service part of the Lasallian core values and encouraged us to do more to give back to the community.

Since its inception, the school has been very open to new ideas and student-initiated activities. Activities such as the Christmas concert, themed assemblies and competitions were mostly student-led, with guidance from supportive teachers, Principals and Brothers making each event a success. These activities give students opportunities to organise events and to gather important leadership experiences.

To foster an inclusive community, the Student Representative Council successfully set up a whole school House System so that students of different year groups could come together during house events and get to know each other better. Festival assemblies are also held so that students can be exposed to various cultures and accept and treat each other as brothers and sisters despite their diverse backgrounds.

Overall, the schooling experience in SJIIM was a unique and enriching one. The various opportunities provided at SJIIM have enabled me to try various activities and helped me grow as a person.

St Joseph's Institution International Malaysia offers scholarships to students entering Year 12 in August 2018.

These Merit-based Scholarships are awarded based on:

- A SJII Malaysia Scholarship assessment
- An interview with the Scholarship Panel
- A written personal statement
- The student's current school academic records
- An endorsement from the Principal of the applicant's current school
- These scholarships cover all or part of the application fee, enrolment fee, security deposit
 and tuition fees for 2 years according to the percentage of the award. The scholarships
 are normally within a range of 25% 100%. However, for this round we will only be
 offering 100% scholarships which will be based on the applicant's academic record and
 archievements



Applications close on Monday, July 16, 2018. Scholarship tests (upon invitation) will take place on July 20, 2018. Short listed applicants will attend a selection interview on July 25, 2018.

- Endorsement from the Principal of your current school

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
