

School Uniform Policy

This policy is written in the spirit of putting into practice our Lasallian core values



Aims and Objectives

Our policy on school uniform is based on the notion that school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride and unity in the school.
- Engenders a sense of belonging to the school and SJII community.
- Is practical and smart.
- Creates an identity for the school.
- Makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance.
- Is designed with health and safety in mind.
- It encourages self-discipline.
- Teaches children value of self-expression without depending on clothes or things being owned.

The Role of Staff

It is the collective role of the staff to ensure that all pupils adhere to the school policy. Staff will have high expectations of students in relation to school and uniform and model high dress standards.

The Role of Parents

We ask all parents who send their children to our school to support the school uniform policy. We believe that parents have a duty to send their children to school correctly dressed and ready for their daily schoolwork. One of the responsibilities of parents is to ensure that their child has the correct uniform, and that it is clean and in good repair.

The Role of the Students

To wear the school uniform with pride and in a manner consistent with this policy.

The Role of The Board

The Board supports the Principals in implementing the school uniform policy. It considers all representations from parents regarding SJIIIM's uniform policy and liaises with the Principals to ensure that the policy is implemented fairly and with sensitivity.

All clothing and equipment brought into school must be labeled. This includes all school and P.E. wear, and shoes.

School Uniform Policy

PE- Elementary School Only

if your child has PE in the morning the children can come to school wearing their PE uniform. They must bring their full school uniform to school with them (including footwear) so that they can change after their PE lesson. If your child has PE in the afternoon the children will be allowed to remain in their PE uniform for the rest of the day.

Jewellery

On health and safety grounds the only items of jewellery we allow children to wear in our school are small single stud earrings and watches. No tongue or facial piercings are allowed.

Hair

Hair should be neat and tidy and be tied up at all times. The school does not permit children to have 'extreme' haircuts that could serve as a distraction to other children. This includes the shaving of letters, logos or names into child's hair, Mohicans, steps/undercuts. Hair cannot be shorter than a number 2. Hair should not be dyed in extremes of colour, including unnatural colour streaks.

Footwear

We require all children from Yr1-13 to wear black enclosed polishable school shoes that should have either laces or a strap. Platform soles, high heels, stiletto heels, canvas shoes or trainers are not allowed.

School Bags

Students must use backpacks purchased from the school uniform shop only.

Make Up

No makeup, coloured nail varnish on fingers or toes or temporary tattoos should be worn.
