Please include your name at the top left-hand corner of each additional document and email it with your application.

- Scholarship tests will take place on Saturday, 9 February 2019.
- Shortlisted applicants from the test will be notified on Friday, 15 February 2019.
- From here, all shortlisted applicants will need to attend a selection interview on Saturday, 16 February
- Interview results will be known two days after the date of the interview.
- Lasallian Leadership and Immersion Camp in August 2019.
