## **Lasallian Reflection from Brother Jason**

Dear Lasallians,

As you may know, the numbers 3 and 5 are significant in SJIIM. 3 stands for our three Lasallian Core Values (Faith, Service and Community) and 5 is for our five Lasallian Principles of Education:



The "3 and 5" [emphasis mine] are a shared reflection from the Brothers' 339 year-old lived history since our first French school which was opened in 1679 (further reading: <a href="https://www.dlsfootsteps.org/cities/reims/st-maurice/">https://www.dlsfootsteps.org/cities/reims/st-maurice/</a>). As a group, we have come to realise that all our schools carry these 3 Core Values and 5 Lasallian Principles of Education embedded within our Curriculum, in our ethos and culture, and in our very mindset, in some degree or another.

In many parts of the Lasallian world, the "3 and 5" will be used as a framework to plan out various activities to commemorate the Tercentenary and the Year of Lasallian Vocations which starts on 25 November 2018. Essential questions around the "3 and 5" ought to be asked by all in order to deepen and refine our understanding of the Lasallian Core Values and Principles of Education. The "3 and 5" isn't just a convenient *framework* but should really be a part of what we stand for; of how we act, transact, interact and react with one other as a community harmoniously and with integrity.

Writing in his *Meditations for Sundays and Principal Feasts*, De La Salle emphasized the importance of harmony within the community: "Union in a community is a precious gem. If we lose this, we lose everything." His emphasis on unity may be understood as *valuing all persons within the school* – the security guards, cleaners, Sodexo staff, teachers, parents, students etc.

In SJIIM, we must never tire of trying to achieve this Lasallian ideal.

This weekend, SJIIM will send a large group of swim team students to compete at Garden International School. If you are in the area, pop in to cheer them on!


#### **Virtues**
