The annual convention is organised by the La Salle Centre, Ipoh which also organises and facilitates programmes for our schools such as, Personal Development and Value Formation, Human Relations Training, Leadership Training, Communications Skills, Counselling Skills, Faith and Spiritual Formation, and Skills in Community Animation.
