Over the span of the week, I was on Kave Service Project mode and accompanied two Year 9 classes on their trips to the <u>Spastic Children's Association of Selangor and Federal Territory</u> (for video, <u>here</u>) and the <u>Children's Home of Hope</u> which is connected to the National Cancer Society of Malaysia.

I have come to realise that, despite the importance of statistics and numbers, what we are *really* about is *to touch the* hearts of the children confided to our care - just one - one at a time. This idea is beautifully illustrated in the photo below of one of our students (Jared Leong of 9L) 'touching hearts' and making a new friend at the Cancer Home.

St John Baptist de La Salle reflected this sentiment when he wrote to the Brothers in the 17th century, encouraging them to play the role of a *Guardian Angel* to their students: *Cheer the faint-hearted, support the weak, and be patient to all* (MTR #6 second point).


