

SJII Malaysia IB Diploma Programme Scholarship

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) is a 2-year educational programme primarily aimed at students aged 16-18. Success in the IBDP offers students the opportunity to gain access to the best universities in the world. From our first graduated cohort, 2 students obtained 44 out of 45 points and over 30% of them scored 40 points and above. In addition to this, 46% of our scholars went on to receive scholarships from foreign universities. They are currently enrolled at New York University Abu Dhabi, Imperial College London, University of Pennsylvania in the USA, University of British Columbia in Canada, Tsinghua University in China, Nanyang Technological University in Singapore, and Osaka University in Japan, to name a few.

St Joseph's Institution International School Malaysia (SJIIM) is offering scholarships to students entering Year 12 in August 2019. The Scholarship Programme aims to enable deserving students to benefit from our unique holistic Lasallian education.

- 2. The scholarship will be awarded to the most outstanding applicants with excellent quality of mind, active participation in extra-curricular activities, positive personal qualities, and strong communication abilities.

Please word-process your Personal Statement, with your name on the top left-hand corner, word count at the end of the personal statement, and email it as a PDF document along with your Application Form.

Additional supporting material (Optional)

You may submit any information or testimonials that highlights significant achievement in the past 2 years that you believe will support your application. A maximum of 12 pages, **submitted as 1 PDF document** will be accepted. Please include your name at the top left-hand corner of each additional document and email it with your application.

Timeline

- Applications close on Saturday, 13th of July 2019 at 11.59PM.
- Scholarship tests and interviews will take place on the 20th and 21st of July 2019.
- Scholarship results to be released on the 29th of July 2019.
- Mandatory Lasallian Leadership and Immersion will commence in the first two to three weeks of August 2019.

Please note:

- All applicants will need to ensure they are available during the dates mentioned above to be eligible for the scholarship.
- We will need applicants to get their passport ready for the Lasallian Leadership and Immersion Camp that will take place in the Philippines. If you cannot send it in by the application deadline, please do so before the tests and interviews commence. Please also ensure that it is valid until at least April 2020.
