The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme is a 2-year educational programme primarily aimed at students aged 16-18. Success in the IBDP offers students the opportunity to gain access to the best universities in the world. From our 2018 graduated cohort, 2 students obtained a result of 44 out of 45 points with over 30% of the cohort scoring 40 points and above. In terms of our scholars, 46% of them went on to receive scholarships from foreign universities. SJIIM had equally good IBDP results in 2019 with the top student scoring 44 points while our school's overall average IBDP points of 37.5 was one of the highest in Malaysia.

Amongst the notable universities that our IBDP alumni have been accepted to are, the New York University Abu Dhabi, Imperial College London, University of Pennsylvania, University of British Columbia, Tsinghua University, Nanyang Technological University and Osaka University.

You may submit any information or testimonials that highlights your significant achievements over the past 2 years that you believe will support your application. A maximum of 12 pages, **submitted as 1 PDF document** will be accepted. Please include your name at the top left-hand corner of each additional document and email it with your application.

Shortlisted applicants will be notified on Monday, 24th February 2020.
