
Future Dates and events- Christmas Mass and the Christmas Bazaar

Technology Guidelines in the High School

High School students are permitted to bring a mobile device to school if it is stored safely in their locker during the day. When school finishes at 3.10pm HS students can use their devices in the foyer. Playing games on the device is not permitted at any time of day or in any location. Devices used at other times in the day will be confiscated.

If teachers wish students to use a laptop during class the teacher will provide the laptops. Students in Years 10 - 13 can their own laptop to use in class, if they have permission from their parents to bring it in. Laptops brought in from home must be connected to the school WiFi and signed into our G-Suite domain, no data access or VPN administration is permitted. If students are following these guidelines they are protected from inappropriate content and this is our ultimate aim. All students are taught these guidelines at the beginning of each year and sign an annual agreement to abide by the guidance. Any student who circumvents the protection put in place by these guidelines will receive an appropriate sanction in line with the severity of the action they have taken.

Elementary School: On-line Safety Meetings

Thank you to all the parents who attended our meetings on Tuesday, and thank you to Mr Woodhams and Ms Wright for delivering this very important information for parents. The content of session covered a number of key issues including clear guidance about the age restrictions for various social media, communication and gaming apps, advice on gaming, using parental controls on devices and raising awareness of the dangers of online grooming in Malaysia. Feedback was overwhelmingly positive and parents said what was useful was "watching the videos, an awareness of the age appropriate levels for the various apps, and being shown how to implement the restrictions on our gadgets". The presentation has been emailed to parents directly.

We were slightly disappointed that not all families were able to attend as there was some very important information. However, following on from this, a number of parents who missed it have expressed an interest in attending a repeat of the session. If you would like us to run it again please complete the form here. We have emailed the presentation to parents rather than share it via class Dojo. We did not feel that some of the content was appropriate for children to see.






What do Mathematics and Art have in Common?

This Wednesday Allan McKeown and the Mathematics Department lead a trip to find out. This term in Art and Design Year 9 has been focused on an Interdisciplinary unit with Math which has led to the inquiry of Islamic style patterns. They have explored three distinct pattern types which are calligraphy, geometric and arabesque. The students have been finding connections with tessellations in the artworks of M.C. Escher and William Morris. The students visited the Islamic Arts museum where they combined their knowledge of Math and Art to create individual geometric artworks.
