

"If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone" Romans 12:18


Chapel opening hours

Stand Up, Speak Up: Online Sexual Harassment

On Monday 10th February, High School students in Years 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 will receive a special assembly on Online Sexual Harassment. This will be followed by High School students in Years 7 and 8 receiving a similar assembly on Tuesday 11th February. Again, the focus of the assembly will be on Online Sexual Harassment. The assemblies have been slightly adapted for the different age groups.

The assemblies will define what online sexual harassment is as well as giving students guidance on how they can receive support should they require it.

Following the assembly, students will participate in four sessions, during tutor time, designed to expand upon the topic and provide opportunities for the discussion of some of the issues raised.
