### **COVID-19 Virus Update**


SJIIM would like to express solidarity with, and to offer our support to, all those who have been infected with the COVID-19, and their families, not just in Malaysia but in countries across the world. We also remember the many healthcare personnel and other caregivers who are offering essential service and care for those infected, even at the risk of their own health and wellbeing. We hope for quick containment of the outbreak in Malaysia, which has seen a spike in new cases over the past few days. We encourage everyone to remain compliant with health and safety procedures, avoid unnecessary exposure and act responsibly to reduce the risk of spreading.

Our thoughts are, of course, predominantly for our two SJIIM families who have been directly affected by the virus. We have been touched by the many kind words and messages of support which we have passed onto the families directly. Please do continue to keep them foremost in your thoughts and prayers.

Finally, we would like to assure you that we are doing everything possible to continue to keep our community safe. To this end, we are continuing with our safety precautions. Please find a further list of FAQs received from parents during this week.

### What are the remote learning plans, should the system be needed?

In the Elementary School there will be different platforms and plans for each phase. We will send out details of these along with online safety declarations on Monday. In the meantime, it would be useful if parents could download the app **ZOOM Cloud Meetings**.



Many of you have already done so and are already using it successfully- thank you.

In the High School we have set up a virtual school learning environment. This is based upon previous experiences and other international schools around the world. It is based on the use of google drive and will include daily lesson plans, use of google classroom and video conferencing. Should the school be closed, students will receive an invite to their class folder that will contain sub folders for all their subjects. They will also receive a detailed instruction document outlining how Virtual School will operate.


This will be a new way of teaching and learning for the majority of the community and we would ask for your help and understanding especially during the first days if Virtual School is needed. If we are closed for up to 2 days we will use Google Classroom to post work as we are currently doing, if the closure is for longer, then Virtual School will be activated.

### Will sports fixtures be returning next week?

We have withdrawn from all sports fixtures and tournaments for the remainder of Term 2. AIMS Sport and KL Sports League fixtures & tournaments have been postponed until the situation eases and restrictions are lifted.

### Will swimming lessons be taking place next week?

Curriculum swimming will not take place next week. Lessons will resume after the end of Term 2. Squad swimming is continuing, but it is optional.



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# Will CCAs be taking place next week?

In the High School next week, school-based CCAs will run as normal. CCAs held at external venues will NOT take place next week. This is due to a directive from the MoH received today.

There are no planned CCA's in the ES next week.

# Are screening checks still in operation?

Yes, we will check temperatures and supply hand sanitation for all who enter the building until the end of term 2.

### Will assemblies and group gatherings be resuming next week?

No, assemblies and group gatherings will not resume this term, this includes planned parent sessions and meetings. Please contact the relevant office if you would like to make an appointment to meet a staff member.

#### Are visitors allowed to enter the school site?

We understand that there are some meetings which are essential. We are therefore designating the rooms in the Admin office next to Mr Kingsley Francis Charles office as visitors' rooms. This way we will be able to maintain a rigorous daily clean. All visitors will be scanned and passports checked to ensure no-one on the site has recently visited affected countries.

## Have any students or staff tested positive for the virus?

No students or staff have tested positive for the virus.

We have been unable to hold our monthly meeting since the outbreak of COVID-19. We understand that there may be issues which parents would like to raise but have not had the forum to do so. 

### High School Sports Day


