Message from Lauren Bayfield - Year 4 Leader and IPC Science Leader

As a founding member of the SJIIM family, I feel comfortable in calling our school my professional home. This is my 6th year working at SJIIM and since arriving in Malaysia in 2016. I have cared for some students throughout their whole school career (founding students), got married, had a child, and seen my child start school here. I would say I feel very welcome at SJIIM!

It was March 2016 when Mr. Bayfield and I first visited the school site. Walking amongst scaffolding and unfinished buildings, I felt a sense of trepidation but also excitement at the opportunity to be part of building something from the ground up; as I walked through the empty corridors I remember thinking 'this is somewhere we will stay'. This feeling has stayed with me throughout my time here and I hope for years to come too. I have watched its 'culture of kindness and care' grow and become more visible in our everyday encounters with our students, staff, parents and stakeholders; in my experience of working in international schools, this is a rarity.

The first year here was a year of excitement, intrigue and creation. The care required for the laying of foundations which we still stand on today truly tested the founding staff's imagination, resilience and drive. A challenge I thoroughly embraced and learnt from.

As the years have passed (so quickly) I have seen people come and go, overcome obstacles, experienced life as an online teacher during a pandemic but two things remain constant for me; my faith in the school and the enjoyment of working in a values driven environment. This in turn has enabled me to develop as a practitioner, and I can now look through the dining hall windows to see my own daughter playing happily with her friends in the early years setting, where I began my time at SJIIM.


School Uniform
