High School Transition at SJIIM

Over the years, we have seen our Elementary School students transition to High School, excited for the new found independence and responsibility. As a school, we review the transition programme annually and continually offer opportunities for our Year 6 students to get familiar with the High School and the expectations that are to come. This year, we decided to adopt a new approach to further support our students by moving to a subject specialist transition model in Year 6. This aims to help students develop their time management, independence and personal organisation skills in a supported way, before they enter the High School. Alongside our end of year transition events, this approach has allowed the transition between the two schools to be more gradual and it gives students adequate time to settle into new routines

Thoughts from Mr. Ruxton (Head of Year 6)




Year 6 students are fast approaching the end of their time in Elementary school and this is a big milestone in their education, they should be very proud of themselves. This year's cohort have enjoyed having a form tutor as their main teacher whilst also benefiting from working with many other teachers across the curriculum. This similar model with High School will allow them to settle into new routines quickly in Year 7. Having Elementary and High School together on one campus is highly beneficial to ensure a smooth transition where teachers from both schools can communicate and plan transition activities to suit the needs of the students each year. Additionally, our Year 7 Ambassadors do a wonderful job advising their peers on their experiences of transitioning between the two schools and Year 6 students always get a lot from these question and answer sessions. Transition is

an important part of Year 6 & 7 to ensure our students enjoy their school experience, build new relationships with peers and staff and are excited about continuing their learning journey in the years ahead."

"Transitioning from ES to HS is not something which should be overlooked. Any change in a person's life can bring with it a whole range of feelings, therefore a good transition program is extremely important to help prepare both students and teachers for the changes that will occur. For the students, it is important that they have a clear description and idea about what High School is and what it entails in order to best prepare themselves and also to ease natural anxieties and worries which can occur from such a move. It is important for students to feel well informed and provide multiple opportunities for students' questions and concerns to be heard and addressed before they begin the next academic year. For teachers, a good HS transition is equally important as it is a time to reflect and emphasise more with our students, making sure we are aware of their worries and concerns and preparing ourselves, both ES teachers and HS teachers, to best support our students during this transition."
