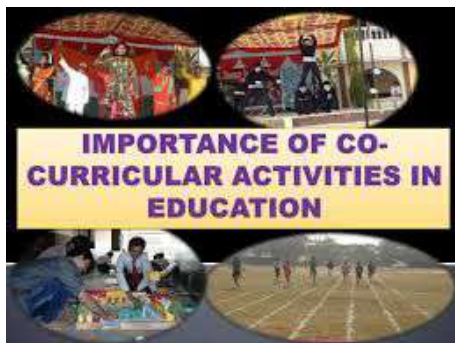
A Levels
