Message by Ian Hayes, Head of Humanities

Humanities Week 7th-11th November

This week we held our annual 'Humanities Week', where the students spent tutor times on Tuesday and Thursday carrying out activities on the various Humanities subjects. This culminated in a 'Big Humanities Quiz' on Friday, with students working in house teams in a general knowledge quiz based on the Humanities subjects. The idea of the week is to give students a taste of subjects that they perhaps have not studied before but may wish to next year, or to look at a different aspect of a subject that they would not cover in their regular Humanities lessons.

The Year 7, students were looking at the Paleolithic period, and the lifestyle and culture of humans who lived over 10,000 years ago. Next week they will finish this by creating their own Paleolithic cave painting. In Year 8, students were focussing on Geography, by creating posters on destinations they would like to travel to. Year 9 students completed a 'lobster fishing' activity based around Economics, whereby they played a game in which they have to decide how best to distribute their lobster pots in order to make maximum financial gain whilst minimising the risk. In Year 10, students examined Philosophy, and in particular the moral relativist and moral absolutist arguments surrounding whether to return a supermarket trolley. Year 11 students carried out research into some famous Psychology experiments, for example Milgram's experiment on obedience, and discussed the ethics of such studies. Finally, Year 12 were also looking at Philosophy, in particular the utilitarian and Kantian ethics in relation to the famous 'trolley problem'.

We are also inviting students to showcase their artistic and creative talents through two Humanities competitions. In one, students will produce and submit a short documentary on a Humanities topic of their choice. In the other, students will be designing a Humanities based mural to be painted on the wall opposite the lift in the Humanities corridor. More details will follow on these, and we look forward to seeing what our students come up with.


I would like to take this opportunity to thank the Humanities team for their hard work in creating all the activities for the students, and the students themselves for their enthusiasm and effort when completing them.


