
#### 5S and 5I trip to Taman Tugu

As part of FOBISIA SJIIM are invited to compete in a Virtual Concerto Competition.



SJIIM students wrote the letter in Spanish and they received the response letter in English. Apart from learning a language, writing creates connections. Our students will be able to write to someone who lives in Spain, intriguing both of them to connect on a more meaningful basis. Instead of making small talk or sending each other short messages, they can reflect on their lives, their weeks, their interest, and the things that make them happy.
