## ZERO WASTE EARTH STORE - Visit from Ms Jacqlyn Wong Yin Thing

"I had a chance to attend the talk with Jacqlyn and Aisha from Zero Waste Earth Store, a social enterprise whose aim is to fulfil the "Zero Waste to Landfill" mission. As part of the SJIM Eco Team, I learned the importance of reducing zero waste in our daily lives and various methods to recycle all types of waste items. I used to think that recycling was the only thing to consider, but I discovered that reducing the amount of waste we produce is the first essential step to creating a sustainable environment. At the end of the talk, we also had a chance to look through different products from the Zero Waste Earth Store made from recycled waste, such as the body scrub made from coffee grounds and medals made from plastic waste!

Listening to the talk with the Zero Waste Earth Store was a valuable time for the Eco Team because it reminded us about the environmental problems humans contribute to and the urgency in raising awareness to address them in our school community. 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
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
