

As we place ourselves under Mama Mary's loving care, may we receive the grace to guide, teach, and walk with our children in faith.














# The Secret of the Chocolate Factory

Each bar contains a mystery prize - just scratch the Gold Ticket contained in each chocolate bar to reveal your prize!
















#### Year 3 Residential:
