Catholic and Christian Community (CCC)

Welcome Back to a New School Year!

We are delighted to welcome our Catholic and Christian community to an exciting new school year. As we begin this term, we look forward to growing together in faith, strengthening our connections, and creating meaningful opportunities for students to live out our values.

This term, the **Young Lasallians CCA** will replace the Catholic CCA and will run every **Friday from 2:50 pm – 3:45 pm**. Sign-up is available on **School Buddy**. This CCA is open to students in **Years 4–6** and will focus on practical ways for children to make a positive impact—serving others and caring for our planet—through meaningful, student-led service projects. This is open to all religions.

Traffic reminders

Reduce speed: To ensure the safety of children, drive responsibly and reduce your speed when driving on campus. **This is a school and the safety of our families is non-negotiable.**

Pick up name cards: All families in the Elementary School and High School have been provided with a card with your child's name on it. Please ensure that you bring this with you to assist us to identify your child as quickly as possible and ensure that all those collecting children can be safely identified.

Car park spaces: Please ensure that you park responsibly and within the designated lines. At busy times, space can be limited so park responsibly. On a number of occasions, cars have been observed to be parked taking up multiple spaces. **We are a community and should show consideration and respect for all.**

Drop off and pick up outside of school: Again, I remind parents that this is not permitted. Whilst it may save you time, it can cause a build up of traffic outside of the school that impacts all. In the morning, in particular, there is little traffic in school meaning that you can serve all members of the community by dropping off at the designated points. Further to this, dropping outside of the school means that your child is having to cross in between cars rather than the supervised areas risking your own child's safety and wellbeing.

Arrive at the correct time: High School parents and drivers should not wait in the pick up lane at the foyer. High School students are not dismissed **until 3:10 pm** so we must ensure that all Elementary School families **can reach their children and exit the school safely.** Parking in the pick up lane leads to a build up of traffic and you will be asked to move.

Blocking of lanes: Please ensure that, particularly when entering the pick up area, you **do not block lanes.** Again, this can lead to a build up of traffic and inhibits parents from **accessing the B1 & B2** car parks and the Elementary School pick up area.
