Curriculum Sessions

In the week beginning Monday, 8 September, our Heads of Year from Early Years to Year 6 will be running curriculum sessions for parents. Reminder on School Expectations

Hair: Students' hair should be neat and tidy. Long hair must be tied up, and extreme hairstyles (e.g., shaved patterns, Mohicans, unnatural colours) are not permitted.

Watches: Smartwatches that transmit data should not be worn in Elementary School.

Shoes: Students from Year 1–13 should wear black enclosed school shoes (lace-up or strap). All-black leather trainers are acceptable, but no platform soles, high heels, or coloured shoes. EY students should wear comfortable closed shoes.

Birthdays: Families may send one small individual treat (e.g., a cupcake) for each child in the class or donate a book to the library. No gift bags or whole year group treats, please.

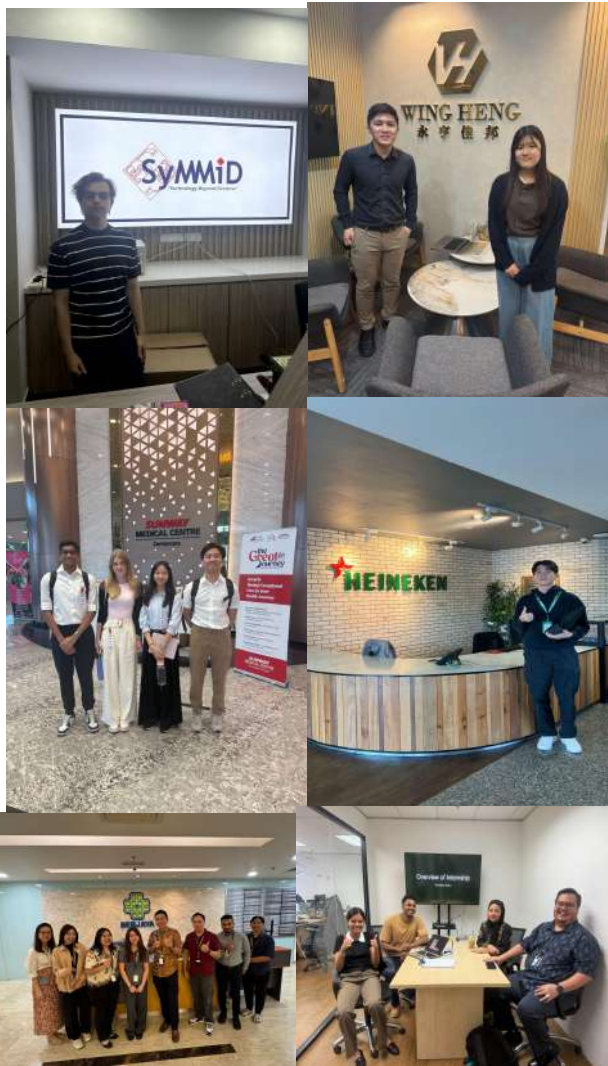

"PROJECT CONNECT": Bridging Classroom Learning with Real-World Experience for our Y12 Students

Our Year 12 students are embarking on an exciting journey of discovery and professional development this week through "Project Connect," our school's innovative work internship program. This initiative is designed to provide invaluable hands-on experience, allowing students to bridge the gap between their classroom learning and the dynamic demands of the professional world.

Their internship durations vary, with some undertaking a week-long placement that concludes today, July 4th. Other students will gain a more extended experience, staying on until July 11th, while a dedicated group will intern right through to August 8th. Notably, some students are even completing two distinct internships, a proactive step as they explore different fields and solidify their career aspirations. While others preferred to do their internship overseas and opted to start during summer break.

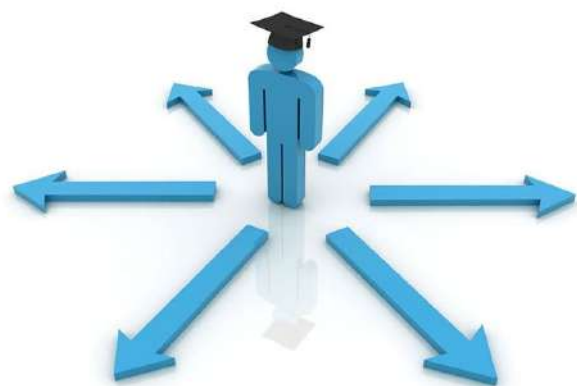


Alumni sharing/ Northeastern University
