This Week's Highlight at SJIIS

Malaysia Day Celebrations - 24th-26th September

In conjunction with Malaysia Day, a three-day educational and cultural exploration event was successfully held from September 24th to 26th by the SJIIS Parent Volunteers (SPV) bringing together high school students, elementary students, parents and teachers, for an unforgettable experience across Kedah and Perlis.

The event aimed to deepen students' appreciation for Malaysia's rich heritage through immersive, hands-on learning experiences — blending history, geography, agriculture, and local cuisine. From paddy fields to ancient civilizations, the journey showcased the unique cultural and natural beauty of the northern states.

Students paid a visit to a traditional paddy planting site and experienced the rewarding process of planting rice by hand. This hands-on activity not only taught the basics of agriculture but also built respect for the effort behind Malaysia's staple food.

Students explored Gua Kelam, also known as the Cave of Darkness - a mystical limestone cave in Perlis. They walked through its dimly lit passageways, learning about the area's tin mining history and geological formations.

The students continued their journey to Lembah Bujang, Southeast Asia's oldest archaeological site, where students learnt about a once-thriving Hindu-Buddhist kingdom. They also had the unique opportunity to participate in an excavation activity.

Participants learnt about Perlis, being the home of the largest sugarcane plantation in Malaysia and gained insight into the crop's harvesting process culminating in a taste of some sugarcane juice.

The experience ended with a food tasting, featuring traditional northern delights like kuih karas and coq peneram, offering a delicious introduction to Kedah's culinary heritage.

The SPV hopes the Malaysia Day experience enriched students academically. The variety of hands-on, historical, and culinary experiences made it an ideal balance of fun and education.

The SPV would like to extend our heartfelt thanks to our parent volunteers who helped make this event an event to remember.


























It was a day that celebrated collaboration, creativity, and the joy of live theatre, an experience we hope our students will carry with them for a long time.


