

We look forward to seeing all of you on **5th December** for our Christmas Fair. Please see poster link <u>here</u>.




Catholic and Christian updates

PASS Assessment

Over the past week and into next week, students are completing the PASS assessments (Pupil Attitudes to Self and School). PASS is a short, age-appropriate online survey that helps us understand how students feel about themselves as learners and about school life in general. It gives valuable insight into areas such as self-esteem, attitudes to teachers, perceived learning capability, and motivation for learning. By analysing the results, we can identify students who may need additional academic or pastoral support. The information also helps teachers strengthen classroom relationships, create positive learning environments, and ensure that every student feels confident and supported in their learning journey.
