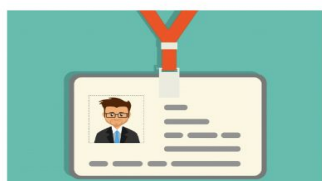

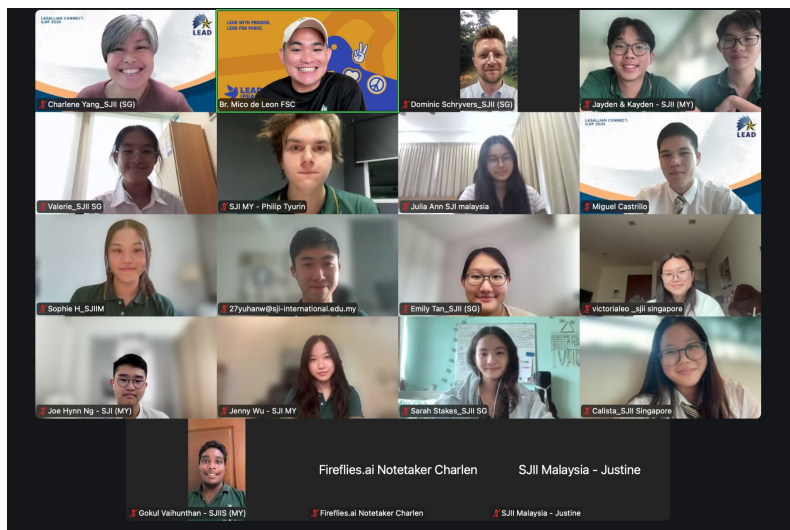
Lasallian Advocacy Awareness Day

As part of their Advocacy and Service Learning unit, Year 11 students campaigned for various UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), creating engaging booths with themes such as #BreakTheBias, #ShineALight, and teams like Passionate Protectors of the Earth, Climate Changers, Fuel Futures, and Master Builders — all highlighting their creativity and commitment to action.

All High School students took part by visiting the booths, engaging in interactive activities, and voting for the most impactful presentation. Lasallian Formation Camp 2025: Briefing with SJII Singapore

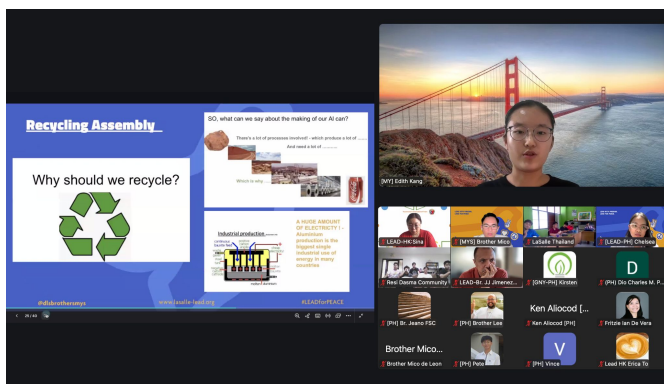
Last October 27, 2025, SJIIS and SJII Singapore joined together for the Lasallian Formation Camp 2025 Online Briefing. The session introduced participants to the Lasallian mission and values that will guide their shared experience at the upcoming camp in La Salle Bamboo School, Sangkhlaburi. Students from both schools had the chance to meet for the first time, build community, and begin preparing for their collaborative service and learning journey ahead.

Lasallian Encounter 2025: Brotherhood on the Move

From 17–20 October 2025, SJIIS students joined 23 young Lasallians from seven La Salle schools across Malaysia for Lasallian Encounter 2025: Brotherhood on the Move at La Salle Centre, Ipoh. Guided by Brothers Mico, Jeano, and Zennel, the four-day programme focused on faith, service, and community through sessions, reflections, and shared experiences. A highlight of the Encounter was the Service Day at Kampung Pawong, an Orang Asli village, where participants put their faith into action by engaging with the local community. The camp concluded with a closing Eucharistic celebration and community gathering, marking the end of a meaningful journey of fraternity, gratitude, and faith in action.

Youth in Action: Lasallians Leading for Climate Justice

Last October 25, the LEAD Justice, Peace, and Integrity of Creation Committee, in partnership with the Youth and Vocations Committee, concluded this year's LEAD for Peace celebrations with Youth in Action: Lasallians Leading for Climate Justice—a regional gathering that became a meaningful space for encounter and dialogue. Brother JJ Jimenez FSC, Brother Visitor, offered reflections on Lasallian Reflection 11: All is Connected, inspiring participants to recognise the interconnection between faith, community, and care for our common home. Edith Kang (Year 10) and Caitlyn Chow (Batch 2025) proudly represented SJIIS, presenting their projects on environmental sustainability. The gathering called all Lasallians to continue discerning and acting together toward a future of hope, justice, and sustainability.
