This year marks my tenth year at St. Joseph Institution International School, a milestone that invites reflection on a decade of learning, growth, and meaningful connections.

I joined SJIS on July 1st 2016, when the school and library were brand new. With empty shelves and no books, I had six weeks to select, purchase, and set up an entire library, both ES & HS before the school officially opened. Those weeks were intense and demanding, and seeing the library ready to welcome students on the first day remains one of my proudest moments.

Over the years, the library has grown alongside the school into a vibrant space where students discover the joy of reading, develop research skills, and build confidence.

Watching students grow from their early years to graduation, and welcoming alumni back as confident adults has been deeply rewarding.

I am especially proud that the library has become one of students' favourite places in school and is often praised by parents and visitors as an exceptional learning space.



This journey has been shaped by the strong support of my colleagues, the SLT & Management team over the years, whose encouragement and collaboration have had a lasting influence on my work in building and developing the library. The Lasallian values of Faith, Service, and Community are lived out daily at SJIS. They are visible in the respect shown to each individual, the willingness to serve others, and the strong sense of belonging that defines our school community.

As I celebrate ten years at St. Joseph Institution International School, I feel grateful and proud to be part of this community. Strengthening Our Lasallian Connections in Singapore



Last week, a small delegation of staff had the privilege of visiting our founding and sister schools in Singapore: St Joseph's Institution and St. Joseph's Institution International, Singapore.

The purpose of the visit was to strengthen relationships, explore opportunities for collaboration, and reconnect deeply with our shared Lasallian heritage. With over 170 years of tradition behind SJI, it was a powerful and inspiring experience to immerse ourselves in the history, values, and spirit that unite our schools.



We were warmly welcomed by staff and students at both schools and were struck by the strong sense of shared ethos across the Lasallian community. Conversations consistently reflected a commitment to learning, mutual support, and striving for excellence, not for recognition, but for personal growth and service to others. Importantly, the visit also reinforced our confidence in the provision we offer here in SJIS. Seeing our core values, approaches to learning, and emphasis on character so clearly mirrored in both Singapore schools affirmed that we are strongly aligned with the very best of the Lasallian tradition. It was reassuring to recognise so much of our own culture, practice, and priorities reflected in schools with such a rich and respected heritage.

Taking part in school traditions and singing familiar songs together was a particularly meaningful moment, reminding us that while we may be based in different countries, we belong to one global Lasallian family - we are indeed one and we are many.

We are deeply grateful to our Singaporean colleagues for their generosity, hospitality, and time, and we look forward to building on these connections for the benefit of our students and wider community.






CCA Term 2



1. Big Emotions to Better Connections with Ms Sonia and Mr Jonny **Friday, 23rd January**








Extension for 1st Payment for EOY Camps June 2026


