As we step into a new year, I would like to wish all members of our community and their families a prosperous and happy 2026.

2026 is a hugely significant year for our school as it marks 10 years since we first opened our doors to students. At the start of the academic year in August, I shared a video with staff of the first time we gathered all of our students together to sing 'We are Lasallian'. In those days, we could just about fit the entire school into our auditorium and, as a founding member of staff, I remember the moment both clearly and fondly.

As a teacher joining a brand new school, it was incredibly exciting. It was a chance to build a culture and identity from the ground up. ### The Korean Parent Community

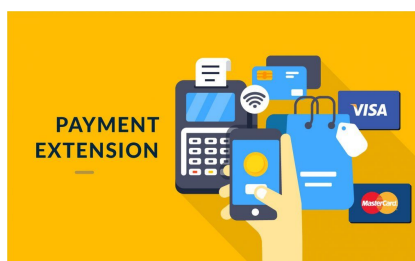
