Gold Accreditation



SJIS Strikes Gold: Achieving the Highest International Standards in Education

We are absolutely thrilled to share a monumental milestone for the St Joseph's Institution International School (SJIS) community! Following a rigorous, four-day on-site evaluation by the **Education Development Trust**, SJIS has officially been awarded the **International Schools Quality Mark (ISQM) at the Gold level**.

According to the official inspection findings published in the report, this prestigious accreditation is valid from March 2026 to March 2031. It represents the highest possible accolade under the ISQM framework. To achieve a Gold rating, a school must be judged as **Grade 1: Outstanding** across all three core operational pillars: *Standards and Achievement, Teaching and Learning, and Leadership and Management*. Thanks to the collective dedication of our students, staff, and families, SJIS achieved a clean sweep of Outstanding judgements.

Inside the Report: What Makes SJIS "Outstanding"

The intensive verification process involved a team of independent inspectors who scrutinized every facet of school life. They visited 55 part-lessons, audited student work, evaluated safeguarding protocols, and conducted 20 formal meetings with leaders, staff, pupils, parents, and the Board of Governors.

The resulting report highlights several key areas where SJIS truly excels on the global stage:

1. Exceptional Academic Standards

The inspection team noted that student attainment and progress in the core subjects of English, Mathematics, Science, and Computing are consistently outstanding across all phases - from the Early Years up through the Sixth Form. Our Cambridge IGCSE and A-Level results were highly praised for comfortably exceeding international benchmarks.

2. A Culture of Intellectually Stimulating Teaching

The report commends our "academically rigorous" classrooms, noting that a shared understanding of high-quality learning is deeply embedded across the entire school. Inspectors observed that our well-qualified educators maintain exceptionally high expectations, cultivating a calm, focused, and supportive environment where every child is cared for.

3. Exemplary Student Character and Leadership

In alignment with our Lasallian heritage, personal development at SJIS was rated as outstanding. Students were celebrated for being polite, resilient, and deeply empathetic. The report lauded our student-led initiatives - such as the Change Makers, Lasallian Youth Movement, and the Eco Team - noting that the school's core values of faith, service, and community are visibly lived out by our pupils every day. Furthermore, our student attendance rate of 96.7% significantly surpasses averages in the UK.

4. A Deeply Trusted Partnership with Families

The inspectors uniquely highlighted the profound bond between the school and its community, stating that:

"Partnerships with parents are highly effective and characterised by high levels of trust and engagement."

Parents interviewed during the inspection expressed immense confidence in the school's academic standards, character formation, and exceptional pastoral care.

Mapping Our Next Steps

While this Gold award validates our status as a top-tier international school, the true essence of the ISQM process is continuous, developmental improvement. To ensure we keep pushing boundaries, school leaders are already incorporating the report's minor recommended area for development into our strategic planning.

This achievement belongs to every individual who walks through our doors. It belongs to our brilliant, resilient students who embody our motto, *"Enter to Learn, Leave to Serve"*; to our passionate faculty who design world-class learning experiences daily; and to our wonderfully supportive families whose partnership makes SJIS a true community.

This is the second time we have completed the survey this year, which allows us to reflect on any changes in students' attitudes since the start of the year. The information gathered will help teachers plan more effectively and ensure each child is supported in the best possible way moving forward, as well as informing handovers to new teachers in August.

Over the years, she has approached learning with focus and determination, asking thoughtful questions, paying close attention in class, and working steadily to strengthen her understanding.

Reflecting on her journey, Yu Xuan shared:

“I’d say not to procrastinate — even though that’s easier said than done. It’s much easier to absorb information when you’re more relaxed and not panicking about how you know nothing the day before an exam.”

Mr Joshua Tay, who has taught Yu Xuan for several years, shared that her achievement is a reflection not only of her ability, but her consistent hard work and initiative in asking meaningful questions in class; and expressed his pride in seeing her growth as a student and an able mathematician.

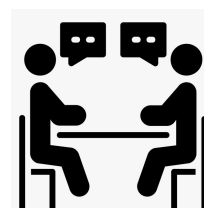
Exam Season Concludes
