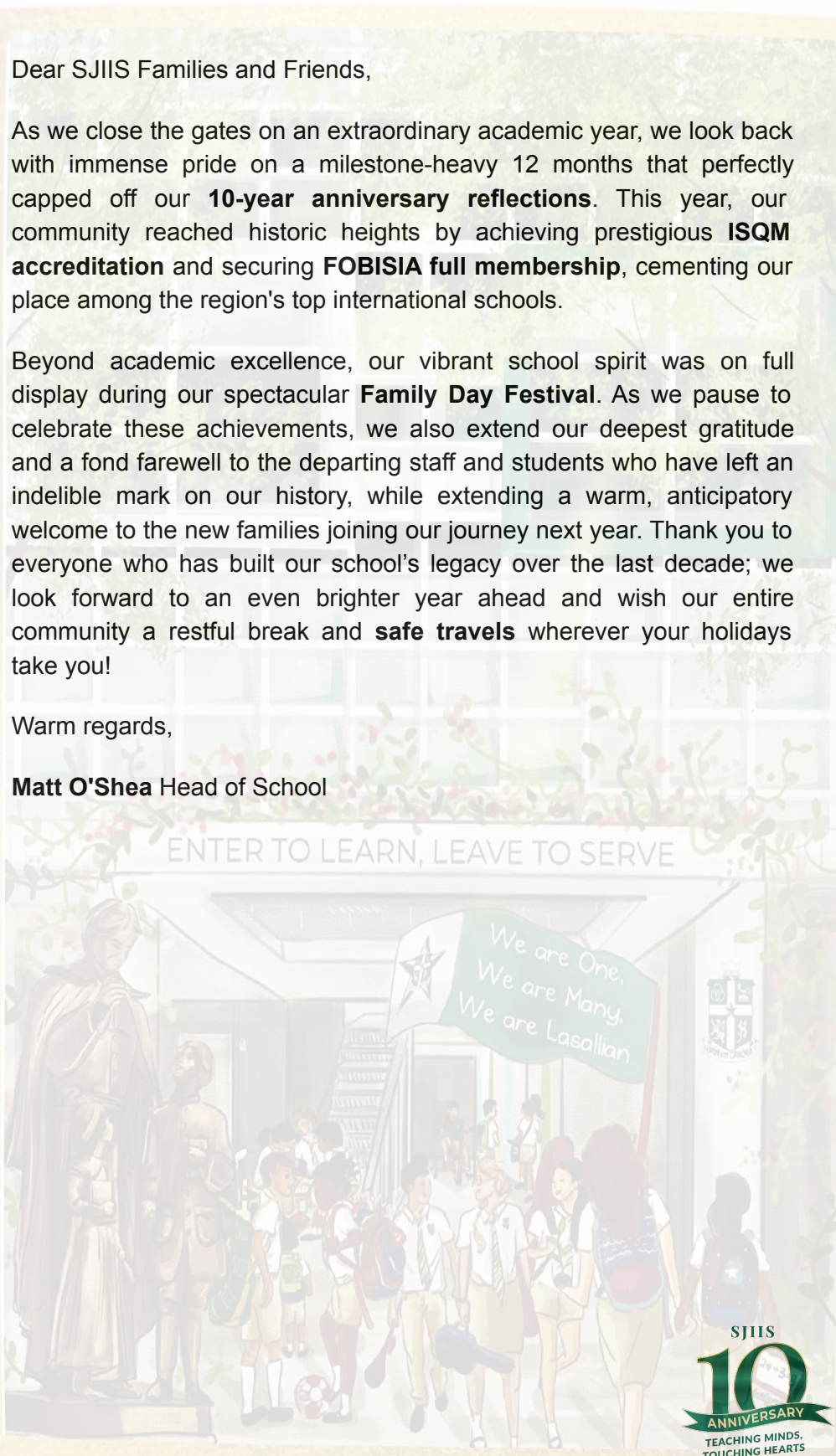

Opportunity for a Magical End to Term 1



We are currently exploring an exciting possibility of organising a **school trip to see Ballet Theatre Malaysia's production of *The Nutcracker* this December**, and need to gauge interest from students and families before confirming anything.

This trip is now open to all students who will be Year 4 and above next academic year.

Last term, Ballet Theatre Malaysia visited our school to perform an excerpt from one of their productions for the entire secondary school, and the response from students was absolutely fantastic. The performance was of an incredibly high standard, and students were completely engaged throughout, with lots of enthusiastic questions during the Q&A afterwards.

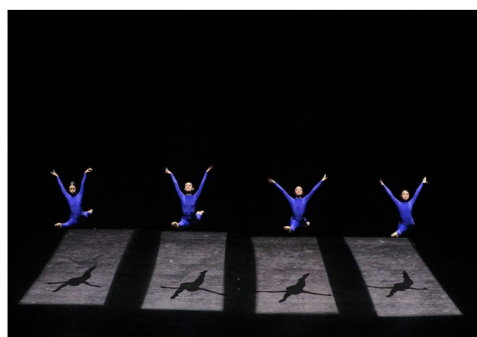
Following that experience, we have been offered the opportunity to attend a special school's afternoon performance of *The Nutcracker* at D Theatre, Empire City on **10th December** (our final day of term). **The [attached PDF](#) outlines the proposed programme. Children would visit the Christmas Fair before leaving for the event and would reach back at school around 4:30 pm on Friday, 10th December**

At this stage, this is **not yet a confirmed trip**. The performance will only go ahead if enough schools are able to commit to attending. However, if it does proceed, ticket prices would be significantly reduced for students, with a **trip fee of around RM85 for the ticket and the bus** (tickets for their normal performances are around RM120-200).

We think this could be a really special and festive way to round off the term before the Christmas holidays. Since I was a child, I have often watched ballet at Christmas and found it really magical. The Nutcracker is an especially festive and fun story.

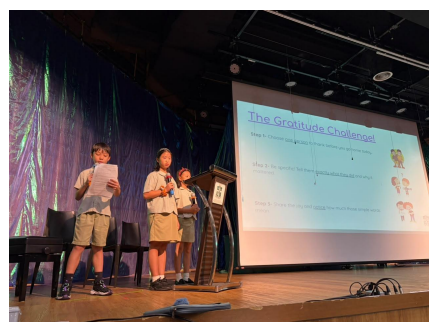


End of Year Gratitude Assembly

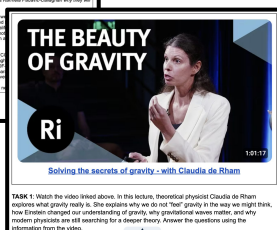
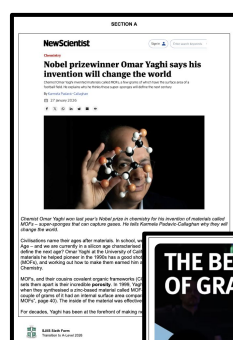


Oxbridge Bubble

On Sunday, 28 June, 9 Sixth Form students along with Ms Quennie and Ms Warrier attended the Oxbridge Society Malaysia Bubble Day 2026, hosted at Garden International School. The event connected with lecturers, alumni, Oxford and Cambridge student representatives, and Oxford University ambassadors to prepare for their upcoming university applications.

The day provided valuable support for students preparing for highly competitive UK university applications, with a focus on admissions tests, interview preparation and collaborative “bubble” learning.

This event supported students in consolidating the knowledge and skills they learned during our in-house university application support sessions, in SJIIS included an LNAT and UCAT preparatory day. SJIIS has also provided with a bank of materials and a pathways booklet to allow students to have a productive summer of preparation.

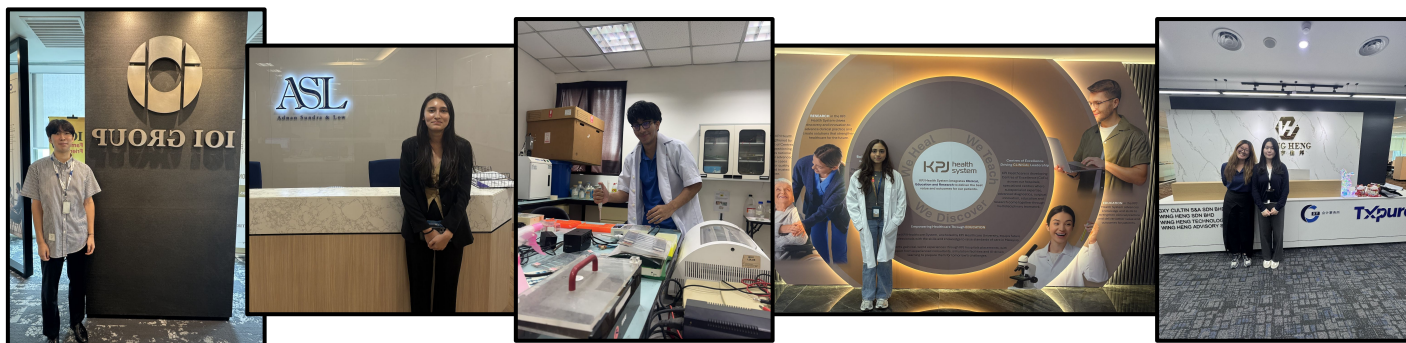

We are very proud of the positive feedback we have received about our cohort from their workplaces.

Experiences like these allow students to step beyond the classroom, develop professional confidence, and begin to understand the different pathways open to them. We will publish a more detailed reflection of their experiences in August.



Plea for Internship Opportunities from Parents

As we look ahead, we would love to broaden the range of real-world opportunities available to our students through Project Connect. If you would be interested in offering internship opportunities in the future, or if you know someone in a key sector who may be willing to support our students, please complete the Google Form below.

This does not need to be through your own workplace. Introductions to contacts in relevant industries would also be hugely valuable. We are particularly keen to hear from those connected to fields such as **medicine, law, engineering, finance, business, technology, architecture, design, media, psychology, education, research, sustainability, public policy, NGOs and the creative industries**.

Parents, alumni and community contacts may be able to support in a range of ways, including:

- Offering summer internships to Year 12 students, either full-time or part-time, for 1–4 weeks
- Offering job-shadowing visits, office visits or field trips for small groups of students interested in a particular field
- Volunteering to give a lecture or talk to students, either in person or online
- Offering mentoring or coaching through one of our student-run societies
- Volunteering as a mock interviewer
- Speaking in an assembly about a particular career, industry or area of expertise

Ms Warrier will arrange a meeting next term with interested parents and contacts to discuss logistics, expectations and safeguarding arrangements. If this drive is successful, we may also be able to develop shorter workplace-shadowing opportunities for younger students in Years 9 and above. Ultimately, when our community helps one another, we can raise opportunities for all our students.
